

JAPANESE POSTAL CODE REGULATIONS

Postal Code Rule	Example
The first line of a Japanese address can be used for the addressee's name.	Mr. Takashi Imaizumi Mr. Kazuki Terada
The second line may include a street name or building number.	Kifune 3-402 (this represents building 402 on the 3 rd street within the Kifune neighborhood)
The third line represents the city and prefecture (a district within the city).	Meito-ku, Nagoya 112-3844 Minato-ku, Tokyo 105-8436
The fourth line can be used to identify the country to which the document or package is being mailed.	JAPAN
